The school collectively has an enthusiastic and dedicated team of 35 teachers in the secondary, the primary and the pre-primary sections. In addition, we have non-teaching and supporting staff. Their coordination and unity with each-other is what that enables the school to function smoothly and grow with new perspectives. Their love and dedication for school is unstoppable.

<u>Trainings:-</u> The learning of learners, current trends of teaching and learning requires a regular updating of teachers. Our teachers including me constantly strived to stay updated by attending various virtual

seminars, workshops and training programmes, teachers attended many trainings through CBSE capacity programmes and through different portals of CBSE. I attended NITTTR training work shop in Chandigarh for entrepreneur skills, capacity building program at Army Public School, Chandi Mandir. Our 2 teachers attended training of Happy classroom by CBSE resource person at Gyan Dham public school. Our teachers are always eager to learn and accept the recent trends in education and ensure maximum learning outcomes in the teaching learning process. On DIKSHA portal teachers attended competency based education, Experiential learning course, Aryabhatt Gaint challenge, Artificial intelligence courses.

<u>Academics</u>: Academics is the core focus of our school. All the possible efforts have been taken, and we will continue to take, to ensure academic excellence in our school. We believe that excellence in academics is the hall mark of our school, as a good institution. Not only this, BIS aims to focus on giving the *best education* and creating a lifelong passion for learning among pupils.

Excellent CBSE class 10 th result, filled us with pride and I feel honoured to mention that, we had 100% results for both the academic years 2020-21 and 2021-22.

<u>Lead:-</u> BIS is co partnered with lead school which provides multimodal learning, subject specific pedagogies and giving unmatched exposure to students, provides time to time Teacher development workshops, too.

In lead for the KG section, we are following integrated curriculum, student focused, thematic and multi-modal. In integrated way we cover music & movement, EVS, English, Math, Creative Arts, Physical Education, and Social & Emotional development.

Detailed lesson plans and resources present in Teacher Tab, School excellence Kit, Reader book, workbook bring integrated classrooms delight.

<u>Primary & Middle:-</u> Teachers prepare for each class using lesson plans and teacher resources on their teacher tabs. With one click the teacher tab connect with smart TV for audio visual learning. Lesson plans guide her/him through teacher led, through group practices and individual practices. Where ever the lesson plans indicates teachers, use learning resources provided by lead for activity based learning.

<u>Elga</u>:- In our curriculum, students do not learn English as the subject, they learn as a skill. We call it Elga, English language and General Awareness. In Elga, students are taught based on current English skill level irrespective of their age. Students are taught using phonics, whole words, reading & listening comprehension, grammar and writing & speaking expression. Each Bistian developing and directing a specific skill. All these integrated with general awareness and values.

<u>CCS</u>:- Lead offers coding and computational skill programs which makes our Bistians ready for future with their designed computer labs. Projects in the CCS curriculum integrate computers with concepts from real life and other subjects. For example, a grade 3 students builds games such as maze games on scratch Jr., a grade 6 student builds a visualization that proves Pythagoras theorem using python.

**Robotics**:- Making our students globally relevant is need of the hour and with the same idea, we are also providing robotics training, too, to our Bistians. In this period, students themselves make some projects with the help of tools available in the Robotic lab under the teacher's guidance.

<u>BIS Engineering</u>:- BIS provides one special period to Bistians weekly, in which students learn innovative ideas to generate, something new under the able stewardship of their teacher.

<u>Labs</u>:- BIS provides all the laboratories Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Math and CCS to Bistians where Bistians get learning by doing

education which go deep in their mind. In labs, Bistians learn to use the tools and conventions of subject.

<u>French Language:-</u> BIS introduced French language in 2019. This is the forth session that Bistians are nourishing themselves with one extra language which is very beneficial for their future.

<u>Meditation:-</u> BIS understands that in modern era, lifestyle is stressful and children are also stressed. Meditation is a simple practice available to all which we are giving here in BIS campus to our Bistians which can reduce stress, increase calmness and clarity, promote happiness and increase concentration.

<u>Co- Scholastic Activities:-</u> With the curricular or scholastic activities BIS is providing many Co- Scholastic activities also to our loving Bistians like Taekwondo, Skating, Horse riding, Cricket, Yoga, music and Dance. For each activity special coach is there who comes weekly and train to our Bistians.

Morning Assembly:- The morning assembly undoubtedly holds the numero uno position out of all the routine activities in a school. It is the face of any school. The assembly starts with the Morning Prayer which is believed to provide peace and serenity to our mind and souls. Probably it's the first platform which is provided to young minds, boosting their confidence towards public speaking and imbibing a feeling of team spirit in their nascent mind, that's why we make a system in BIS of class wise assembly. For a week, one class is on duty so that every child should get a chance to speak. Even our kindergarten students are also trained for conduction of the assemblies.

<u>Teacher's Prayer:</u> In BIS, every morning teachers sing a prayer song for loving Bistians to tell them how precious they are for them, teachers understand the young minds and they can bring their concerns and worries to them and teachers are their friend, philosopher and guide.

**Four Houses**:- The students and the teachers are divided into four houses which are headed by captains and vice - captains who are guided by the house masters. Inter house competitions are organized for various cultural and co-curricular activities. The house system fosters a spirit of co-operation and healthy competition.

## **CBSE Activities:-**

<u>Hubs of learning</u>:- CBSE has made cluster of eight schools, Chinmaya Vidyalaya, Nauni is the lead school and has planned sessions/ activities for throughout the year, with partner schools namely Baddi International, Bhojia Vidyapeeth, New Ghan Dham public school,

Annand school Parwanoo, Bal Bharti School, the Good shepherd and S.V.N school. Hubs of learning are formed as cluster of 4-8 neighboured schools each, for the purpose of collaborative growth, promoting self-improvement and for ensuring the enhancement of the quality of education, the first meeting was held in Chinmaya Vidyalaya, Nauni. From each school Principals and one chief nodal (one teacher) attended the meeting and together all planned one activity calender for the whole year. From BIS also Principal Mrs. Marin Paul and academic cocoordinator Mrs. Rishu Bala attended the meeting. All schools decided that every month one activity will be planned in one school and all other school will participate over there with their students.
