To increase the understanding about India G20 presidency and to encourage the Bistians to relate to different parameters of **G20 declamation** was conducted.

NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF TECHNICAL TEACHERS TRAINING AND RESEARCH CENTRE(NITTER) had selected our school among the few schools from Himachal Pradesh and our selected students went to NITTER,Chandigarh for training session to enhance their entrepreneurship skills. Master Akhilesh Tiwari from class 10 got first position in generating ideas and Master Harsimer Singh from class 10 became runner up in 6 months entrepreneurship and rural development programme organised by NITTR.

Music binds our soul heart and emotions to bring out the singing talent of the students. Solo Singing Competition was organised at **IEC University** and our two students Bhoomika Verma from class 9th and Jay Shrutik from class 5 won gold medals in this **solo singing competition**.

BIS celebrated **Veer Bal diwas** on 26 December 2022 and our students delivered their speeches and a movie based on 4 sahibzada's was shown to them.

Our 7 students went to Pinjore to Vivekanand Millennium School to participate in different types of activities conducted by **Srijanoday Vivekananda samiti**. Our four students Trisha, Vanshika, Viviana and Tamanna got A+ and medals. To inculcate the natural aptitude and scientific abilities among pupils, our school conducted **future tech Olympiad and space zone Olympiad**.

BIS understands that in modern era, lifestyle is stressful and children are also stressed. **Meditation** is a simple practice available to all which we are giving here in BIS campus to our Bistians which can reduce stress, increase calmness and clarity, promote happiness and increase concentration.

With the curricular or scholastic activities BIS is providing many **co-Scholastic activities** also to our loving Bistians like Taekwondo , Skating , Horse riding , Cricket, Yoga , music and Dance. For each activity special coach is there, who comes weekly and train to our Bistians.

The **morning assembly** undoubtedly holds the numero uno position out of all the routine activities in a school. Probably it's the first platform which is provided to young minds, boosting their confidence towards public speaking and imbibing a feeling of team spirit in their nascent mind, that's why we make a system in BIS of class wise assembly. For a week one class is on duty so that every child should get a chance to speak. Even our kindergarten students are also trained for conduction of assemblies. Before starting the morning assembly every day our Bistians recite positive affirmations which give them positive energy and good vibes and make their mind and body healthy.

In BIS , every morning, **teachers sing a prayer song** for loving Bistians to tell them how precious they are for them.

At the beginning of the session, in the academic planner school has given eleven topics of **Virtue of the month**, one for every month, according to the given topic or theme, each class prepares some ideas or work and decorates their class bulletin board with the help of classteachers.

BIS establishes two **libraries** in school. One for KG section and one for seniors so the Bistians can develop and inculcate reading habits in their nature.

Each house is managed by Head teacher, associate teachers, House captain and House vice captain. Baddi International School took an innovative step and started a **Radio show** in school premise to develop common core skills like public speaking, creating a narrative. This allows students to build a place of expression, awaken their critical thinking. Class wise-students get a chance at the time of lunch break for 15 minutes to perform their Radio show. In Baddi International School, The students have been learning to **ride a horse** from the last 7 years. This is the equestrian sport which they are not able to learn in the Baddi area but BIS is providing this opportunity to students.

**Taekwondo** is the art of self- defense. It is recognized as one of the oldest forms of martial arts in the world. In Baddi International school, students are learning Taekwondo from the last 7 years but school has started this martial art training for the kindergarten students too, from last year.

Our two Bistians went for **Skating Competition** at M/S Sood Multi academy, Kurali on **8 October 2023** and our two Bistians Master Arnav from 3<sup>rd</sup> B and Master Harshit From class 7<sup>th</sup> got gold medal.

The space olympiad Junior competition encourages students to "Be creative . **Space Olympiad** junior asks them to think about the future of space and science technology and to creatively communicate their ideas. In BIS we conduct level 1 on 26th July and level 2 on 11th

october. In level 1 our 20 students participated and 2nd level our 7 students participated and got certificates.

**Trip to Maple Jungle:-** To give an adventurous experience to the students BIS organized a trip to Maple Jungle camp on 20<sup>th</sup> October.

On 31st October, 2023, Bistians celebrated the **National Unity Day**. The day is celebrated as the birth anniversary of Vallabhbhai Patel who had a major role in the political integration of India. Bistians took pledge, run for Unity, gave speech to tell about the Sardar Patel's contribution for unity of India.

With an endeavour to promote integrity, transperancy and accountability in public life **vigilance awareness week** was observed in our school from 30<sup>th</sup> October to 5<sup>th</sup> November. With the theme "say no to corruption".

In **CBSE cluster sports** our 2 Bistians participated in Taekwando in different weight catagories

Heritage India Quiz:- A National level online quiz competition was organised by Heritage foundation, our three bistians participated in it.

**Bharat Vikas Parishad** singing & Quiz competition were organised in Shivalik science school, kharuni. In both the catagories our bistians participated and performed "Hindi & Sanskrit group song and junior & senior Bharat ko Jano quiz competition.

On 2<sup>nd</sup> of November, The Energy and Resource Institute (TERI) is organising **Green Olympiad**. It is an environment based examination for students from classes 4-12. In BIS we conducted green olympiad and our 12 students participated in it. Children are loved by one and all. Children's Day was celebrated on **18<sup>th</sup> November 2023 in BIS.** Tiny-Tots decorated themselves in the colourful attire and enjoyed their day.

In session 2021-22 BIS established a culture of Parent-Teacher association. From each class we selected one parent as a representative for that particular class. In the last week of each month **PTA meeting** is organised in school campus. All the school related matters are always discussed in this meetings openly with all the members. This month's PTA meeting was held on 22nd November, 2023.

We registered **VSRO olympiad** for differernt subjects like:- VSRO chemistry, mathematics, physics, science olympiad and many students have done registration for that.

**French language:-** BIS introduced French language in 2019 for Bistians. This is the 5th year that Bistians are nourshing themselves with one extra language which is very beneficial for them, and even started conduction French assembly,too.

Learning from Nature:- In the process of learning from nature Bis always giving lesson to Bistians how to protect nature and keep our Nature to green & clean. This year at the beginning Bistians cultivated banana trees in school compound and got fruits, too. But in school students got experiential learning that not only as a fruit banana is useful but even each and every part of banana tree useful like leaves can use as plates to serve food. Flower is used as green leafy vegetable. Stem is used as salad. In school we cooked food with all these parts, and students learnt and enjoyed tasty dishes.

Time to time Bistians got chances to walk in Nature, too and enjoyed different flowers, plants, birds, animals.

<u>**Club Activities:-**</u>Club activities help students develop sense of unity and teamwork, learning how to work with others in reaching the same goals. It helps learners develop social skills. BIS also established some of clubs like Eco club, English club, Hindi Club, Nature club etc. These clubs organised different activities time to time like poem recitation, calligraphy, plantation drive etc.

Our nature club cultivates a kitchen garden in school campus and our eco club gave message to our Bistians & to our parents for say no to plastic and creates management area under the club activities.

A **disaster management committee** has been framed in BIS as per NEP-2020. Under this committee one fire control mock drill was organised in school by the fire brigade officials. Bistians learnt how to make control on different type of fire, with different methods.

**20th HP Yogasana sports championship** organized in Shivalik science sr. sec. school, kharuni. Our Bistians bagged many prizes. One of our Bistian Ekansh from 3rd std. not only achieved gold medal even got selected for the National championship.

Under the **hub of learning** activities our Bistians participated in Debate competition which was held in Anand school, Parwanoo through online mode. Bistians got participation certificates.

Our Bistian Master Harshit Anand participated in **North West Championship** which was held in Haryana ,got silver medal in 40kg weight category. Now Harshit is selected for **National level Taekwondo championship** going to be held in December in Bihar.He is one among others going to represent Himachal Pradesh. I rarely congratulate our Harshit for his dedication and our taekwondo team for their determination. <u>Himachal Pradesh State Taekwondo Championship:-</u> Our Bistian Aryan Thakur participated in HP State Taekwondo Championship and got bronze medal.

#### Kindergarten Activities:-

**On 8th May** our tiny tots learnt their lesson through motor skill activity. They put balls in basket and learnt through playway method.

**On 19th May, a Vocabulary** competition was organized.Students participated in vocabulary activities.

**<u>26th May, Match Stick Activity:-</u>** Match stick activity was done by kg section to enhance their problem solving skill.

**<u>28th May, Activity 'Learn New' In Computer Lab:-</u>** To give practical knowledge of computer to students, they have done different activities on the computer.

**1st June, Wooden Powder Activity:-** This activity was conducted for the students of Kindergarten. Our little buds learnt to make different patterns using wooden powder. They also learnt how to use waste material by using their creativity.

**<u>27th July, Poem Recitation(KG):-</u>** Students recited the different poem with props in colourful dresses with voice modulation and gestures on this day.

Learning a sentence even is hard until creativity is added to it. Keeping this in mind a **story telling** activity was organized in BIS. On this day the little champs of BIS were asked to dictate a story using props, through this, champs conquering their stage fear represents wonderful stories.

We Organized **rubber band activity, bowling activity, Show and Tell Activity** to strengthen the creativity skills, verbal skills and to foster public speaking competency of the young minds. It enabled them to improve their descriptive skills by communicating feelings, thoughts and emotions with words. It was an interesting and a thrilling experience for the Bistians.

**Blue colour day** was celebrated in the school campus. The dress code of the day was blue. Excitement and enthusiasm was visible everywhere.
